June 8th marks the celebration of Pentecost this year, an important (but not always well-remembered) holy day of the church calendar. Pentecost memorializes the day that the Holy Spirit descended upon the earliest Christians in an upper room in Jerusalem, changing, equipping, and emboldening them to become evangelists for Christ. It is often referred to as the "birthday of the church," and all true believers are connected to it through the miracle of the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Out of curiosity, I decided to look up what John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, had to say about the Holy Spirit. Without digging too far, I came across a sermon he gave at Oxford, on Pentecost Sunday, in 1736.

If you'd ever like to read John Wesley's sermons, even just to get a taste of what sort of things he had to say, they are easily found on the internet, often cross-referenced by topic. His 18th century writing style can be a stumbling block, and Wesley was also not one to "dumb things down." His sermons require thought and attention, but they helped transform Christianity in England during his lifetime.



This particular sermon was not about Pentecost itself, but about the Holy Spirit. And Wesley is clear that the Spirit is a fundamental aspect of living the Christian life. After the disobedience of Adam and Eve, "When man would not be guided by the Holy Spirit, it left him." Without guidance by the Spirit, "He was now a mere animal...fallen under tutorage of the evil one."

However, Christ was sent to allow for our adoption by God into the family of heaven, and through our acceptance of salvation we have a second chance. "Considering what we are, and what we have been, nothing less than the receiving of that Spirit would be redemption to us." And so through accepting the gift of the Spirit through the sacrifice of Christ, we have communion with God and hope for a new life now, and an eternal life ahead of us in heaven.

"But I think the true notion of the Spirit is, that it is some portion of, as well as preparation for, a life in God, which we are to enjoy hereafter." In other words, the Holy Spirit gives us a foretaste of heaven in this life, and leads us into glory in the life to come. Follow Him, and you will never be lost again.
